COVID 19 *Guidelines for Dance Invitationals

*These guidelines are for North Dakota dance team use when hosting a North Dakota Dance Invitational. This is a guide for hosting a safe event during the COVID pandemic. No sanctions will be given to teams, coaches or invitational hosts if guidelines are not imposed as written. Along with these guidelines host teams/schools are strongly encouraged to follow their city, district, county and state COVID 19 guidelines.

October 7, 2020

- 1) Arrowed Hallways to help flow of traffic
- 2) Spread out dressing rooms
- 3) Spectator vouchers given to teams to allow only a certain number of attendees
- 4) Marked seating areas for each team's spectators
- 5) Sanitize floor between routines
- 6) Dancers temperatures taken when entering the building
- 7) Spectators temperatures taken when entering the building
- 8) Spectators and staff required to wear masks
- 9) Dancers required to wear masks when in the hallway. Dancers are not required to wear masks to and from staging or when performing.
- 10) Pre packaged concessions only. An effort should be made to guide the flow of traffic and allow for social distancing while waiting in line.
- 11) No contact between teams
- 12) No hallway practicing - Practicing should be done only in dressing rooms or in a designated area if host chooses to supply one. Practice area should be limited to one team at a time. Host may supply a schedule & supervisor for the designated practice area to avoid over use by teams and avoid overcrowding (may run like nationals.)
- 13) Hosts should make an effort to stage/stack school teams together i.e. Fargo varsity performs , followed by Fargo JV etc.
- 14) Staging: Runners should be available to guide teams to staging and staging should be limited to 3 teams at a time (social distanced) EXAMPLE: Team 1 on the floor; team 2 on deck; team 3 in staging.
- 15) Awards should be done with only one division at a time on the floor and seated a minimum 6 feet apart and mask should be worn. EXAMPLE: Middle school receives all their awards leaves the floor then JV takes the floor and then Varsity.
- 16) One captain or one designated team member should come up for award and take it directly from the table.
